Why would: The Beatitudes / The Parables / The Great Commission

- 5] Do not be troubled by THESE things
- 6] Nation will rise against nation
- 7] Kingdom will rise against kingdom
- 8] Famines
- 9] Pestilences
- 10] Earthquakes in various places

- 1] They will deliver you up to tribulation
- 2] They will kill you
- 3] You will be hated by all nations for My name's sake

### THEN

- 4] Many will be offended
- 5] Many will betray one another
- 6] Many will hate one another

### THEN

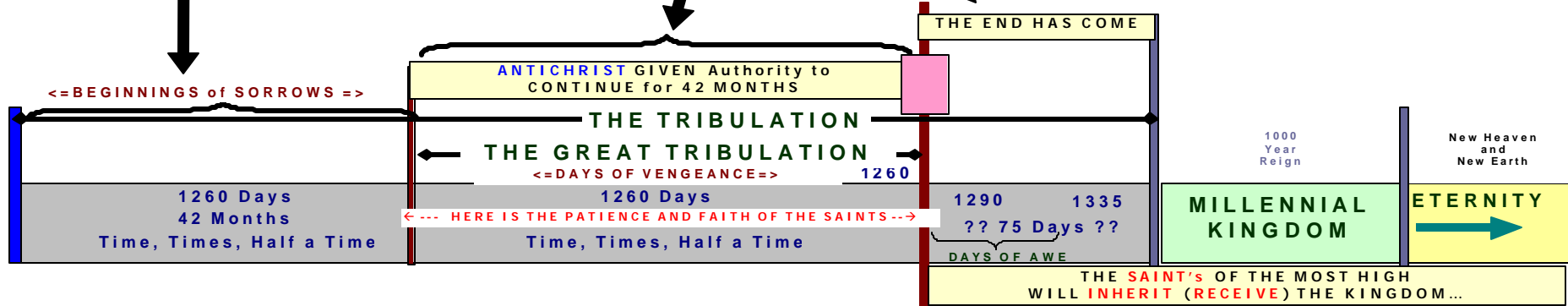
- 7] Many false prophets will rise up
- 8] Many will be deceived by false prophets
- 9] Lawlessness will abound
- 10] The love of many will grow cold

- 11] He who endures to the end shall be saved
- 12] This gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world
- 13] The gospel will be as a witness to all the nations

- 14] The end will come

Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house. And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath.

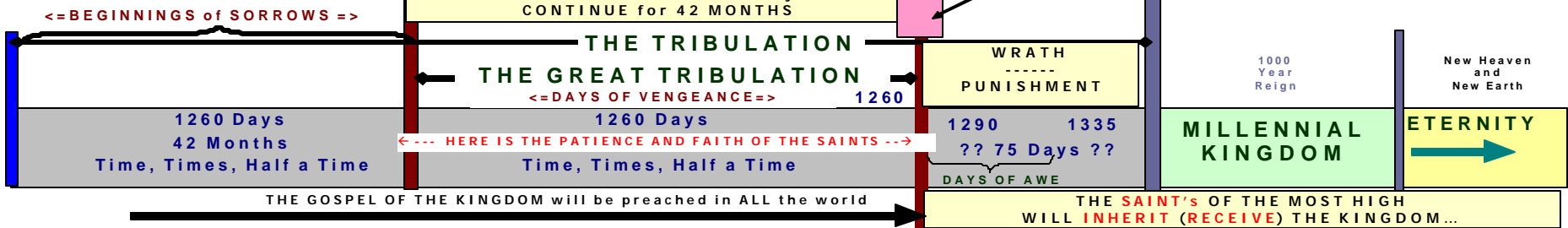
ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION

For THEN there will be **great tribulation**, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

THEN

- 1] If anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it.
- 2] False christs and false prophets will rise
- 3] False christ and false prophets will show great signs and wonders to deceive
- 4] The signs and wonders will be so convincing, the very elect could be deceived by them, if it were possible
- 5] See, I have told you beforehand.
- 6] If they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out;
- 7] If they say, 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe it.

But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.



"Now learn this parable from the fig tree [ISRAEL]: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves [forming as a NATION], you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near--at the doors! [Know that MY coming is NEAR, even at the door...] Assuredly, I say to you, this generation [the generation that sees all these things] will by no means pass away till all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. For wherever the carcass is, there the eagles will be gathered together.

AFTER THE TRIBULATION OF THOSE DAYS

"Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

Then two men will be in the field: one will be taken and the other left. Two women will be grinding at the mill: one will be taken and the other left. Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

THEN

- 1] Moon will not give its light
- 2] Sun will be darkened
- 3] Stars will fall from heaven
- 4] Powers of the heavens will be shaken

THEN

- 5] The SIGN OF THE SON OF MAN will appear in heaven
- 6] All the tribes of the earth will mourn
- 7] All the tribes of the earth will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory
- 8] The Son of Man will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet
- 9] The angels will gather together the elect of Jesus from the four winds, from one end of heaven to another

A CALL TO PERSEVERE, BE WATCHFUL, AND WARNING OF NOT BEING FAITHFUL OR WISE- WATCH!

Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his master made ruler over his household, to give them food in due season? Blessed is that servant whom his master when he comes, will find so doing. Assuredly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all his goods. But if that evil servant says in his heart, 'My master is delayi his coming, and begins to beat his fellow servants, and to eat and drink with the drunkards, the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for h and at an hour that he is not aware of, and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites.
